



## Group trips to ALBANIA 2010

*Eastern European Outreach is organising several trips to Albania, flights will be from London to Tirana, the capital of Albania. In Albania travelling will be mainly by the means of a minivan. The trip is suitable for participants in a good physical condition.*

### DATES 2010

Dates: Spring: 6 - 13 March  
Autumn: 2 - 9 October.

Visiting: Tirana, Shkoder (north) and Tepelena (south)  
Approx. price: **£825** (incl. flights, accommodation, local travelling, meals)



### BACKGROUND

Until the early nineties Albania was officially an atheistic country. People who owned a Bible at that time were risking their lives. After the fall of communism in 1990 Albania also changed. Communism left a very strong mark on the country, almost all factories closed down, not much is being produced in Albania at this very moment. Most products are imported from Greece and Italy. Corruption is a major problem; the mafia has a very strong presence in the country, thriving on car theft, human trafficking and drugs. Salaries are very low, and living on benefits is impossible. Often there is not enough money to buy the basics such as food and clothes. Many Albanians do not see any possibilities for work and a better life in their own country and move abroad to work and support their family back in Albania.



### CURRENT SITUATION

The current situation in Albania is very difficult, material help is very much needed. The country is a mixture of the Middle Ages and the 21<sup>st</sup> century; the difference between Tirana and the villages is enormous. Many people are desperate. Also the future is bleak, education is of a very low standard and teachers are not motivated.

Despite all the problems in the country, the Albanians are very friendly and hospitable hosts. Over the years EEO has gained valuable experience in organising trips to this fascinating country.



### GOAL

The goal of the group trip is to encourage the poor and be a blessing for our brothers and sisters in the Lord, this is achieved by the traveller being there, and also by handing out food parcels and clothes. Albania has changed over the past 20 years from an atheistic to a Muslim country. The visits are very important for our Christian brothers and sisters. Together with our local contact person Renato Jani a varied programme will be made. Important elements will be visiting families, institutions, orphanages and projects. There will also be space to visit the local tourist attractions.

### SPECIAL VISITS

As much as possible we try to plan in personal visit requests from participants, for example if they want to visit their sponsor child.

## Terms and conditions

You need to:

- have a valid passport, which is still valid at least three months after your return.
- be in a physical condition to cope with the amount of walking.
- be prepared to give up smoking and drinking for the duration of the trip

### Costs

The costs of this journey are £825 (estimate)\* per person. This amount includes full board, accommodations, snacks on the coach, hot meal on the last day and the excursions. Married couples can claim, if they wish, a £50, reduction in the total sum
